

COLLABORATION AGREEMENT

March 16, 2017

Moscow, Russia

The Supreme Organization for Organized Industrial Zones (hereinafter – “OSBUK”), Turkey, represented by the Chairman of Board Memis KUTUKCU and Association of industrial parks (hereinafter – “Association”), Russian Federation, represented by the Cochairman of the Board Maxim PAZDNIKOV, collectively named “the Parties”, signed the current Agreement and agreed about next topics:

1. The Parties intend to develop collaboration in the field of investments in real economy sector and support for the Turkish and Russian business in Russia and Turkey;
2. To perform the exchange of information on prospective Russian-Turkish investment projects;
3. Preparation and carrying out of joint events on localization of Turkish companies on the territory of Russia; Russian companies on the territory of Turkey.
4. Providing mutual methodological support in case of implementation of projects in the field of industrial parks and production localization.

This Agreement reflects the intention of the Parties and does not impose any financial obligations.

This Agreement doesn't limit the "Association" and the "OSBUK" in dealing with other third parties.

This Agreement shall become effective on the date it has been signed by the Parties for the period of 2 (Two) years. Any Party may exit this Agreement at any time upon notice to the remaining Party for 1 (One) month prior to the termination.

This Agreement is prepared and signed in the English language in two copies, one copy for each Party. The Parties clearly understand the content and the essence of this Agreement.
